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Maintenance Inspections for Métis Urban Housing

Once again Annual Inspections will begin in May 2018 and continue until the end of July 2018, Tenants will be advised in writing when the unit will be inspected. This is a great time for spring cleaning and decluttering your house and yard.

- $^\infty$ $\,$ Ensure the locks are original to the unit, if we are unable to access unit, we will change the locks and charge this service back to you.
- ∞ $\,$ Ensure the cabinets under bathroom and kitchen sinks are clear of clutter to be able to access the plumbing.
- ∞ Smoke detectors need to be put back into place and in working order.
- ∞ Move all items away from the hot water tank and furnace. Change the furnace filter and make sure there are working lights in the basement and others rooms in your house.
- If you have pets please make sure you do not lock your pets in rooms that we need to access.
- ∞ $\,$ Clean yard of all garbage , if you have a pet this includes cleaning up after them as well.
- ∞ $\,$ Make a list of concerns about your unit, and give or leave for our maintenance team.
- ∞ Ensure all rooms are accessible.

Budgets Can Be Great!

We began our household budget in the summer of 2007. At the time, we had three small children aged three, five and six and were quite financially strapped. My husband and I were tired of living paycheque to paycheque, so we made the decision to start a budget and stick with it for a whole month to see how we felt. As the month went on what surprised us the most was how much *more* money we felt we had to make ends meet, even though we did not have any more money than before. Needless to say: we have been budgeting ever since and could not imagine our lives without it!

To begin there are a few simple steps to follow:

- 1. Pick a period (usually one month) and track your spending (this will give you a better idea of your variable expenses).
- 2. Find or create a budget template, there are plenty of templates online. Your balanced budget should include your **income** *less* your **savings** and **expenses**.
- 3. Prepare a balanced budget.

<u>**TIP:**</u> Manipulating your variable expense (groceries, clothing, entertainment etc.) is the easiest way to balance the budget.
